



# EUROPEAN HERITAGE TRAINING COURSE WITHIN THE WORLD HERITAGE CAMPAIGN, PORTO 2021

## Presentation

The Heritage Training Course “Conservation of original elements to preserve the authenticity of Porto’s urban heritage” will provide a unique opportunity for a group of young heritage professionals from around the World to discover the ancient city of Porto by exploring it, through the different lens of urban heritage conservation and rehabilitation. The training course aims to identify the state of conservation of the buildings at the World Heritage site, as well as their level of authenticity while recording the undergone transformation of recent times. The course will engage participants the promotion of good practices directed to heritage conservation, and maintenance, as well as to respond to the challenges of endeavours caused by the lack of the monitoring, a common issue across World Heritage cities, regarding rapid transformation due to mass tourism and real estate pressure.

The Training Course is part of the European Heritage Volunteers Programme 2021 and is listed as an action camp within the UNESCO WHV campaign 2020/2021. It is organised by APRUPP - Associação Portuguesa para a Reabilitação Urbana e Proteção do Património / Portuguese Association for Urban Rehabilitation and Protection of Cultural Heritage jointly with European Heritage Volunteers and Municipality of Porto, in collaboration with the University of Aveiro, Portucalense University –Gallaecia Department, Association Centro da Terra and has the financial support of the Municipality of Porto, European Heritage Volunteers, AOF and PRETENZA. The event has additional support of CACAO, NCREP, P3R, KERACOL, TECNAN, WEMO-Tec and the institutional support of Associação Portuguesa de Promotores e Investidores Imobiliários (APP II), IC-FEUP, DEMAC-UA, CICECO-UA.

This initiative has the institutional support of the UNESCO Chair entitled ‘Heritage, Cities and Landscapes. Sustainable Management, Conservation, Planning and Design’ from the University of Porto. This UNESCO Chair promotes training and research following UNESCO’s mission and goals, fostering sustainable management and conservation of cultural heritage, as well as quality planning and design for built heritage, cities and landscapes.

**APRUPP** is the coordinator of this Training Course. APRUPP is a private non-profit association, based in Porto, founded in 2012, with the aim of promoting and disseminating the concept of urban rehabilitation as the main vehicle for safeguarding the identity and valorisation of built heritage. It is their belief that the dissemination of this concept through the transmission and study of good practices, exchange of knowledge and an adequate technical training, will promote the preservation buildings with historical interest, as well as decisively influence the reduction of social asymmetries and alert to the need for participation of citizens in the preservation of heritage.

**European Heritage Volunteers** is one of the leading actors in the field of volunteering for heritage and non-formal heritage education in Europe. The European Heritage Volunteers Programme connects heritage-related institutions, organisations and heritage professionals into a synergic network engaged with volunteering and educational activities dedicated to heritage. It provides the opportunity for young heritage professionals to gain important educational insights, to acquire the necessary practical skills and to explore the different fields of heritage conservation, through a diverse catalogue of two-week projects and training courses organised each year jointly with the partners within the network all around Europe.
